The City received twenty four grant application requests; Denise Obrero will include the committee's recommendations as part of her Base Budgets and, ultimately, the City Council will determine the Funding Allocations for FY 2014-15.

b) Las Posadas Procession in Vista Los Mares was cancelled this year.

c) SCC Sub-committee updates: Susan Parmelee provided an update on the SOS Club's ice skating field trip this month. There were twenty teenagers that attended. The S.C.H.S. Club was started this academic year and offers students a healthy outlet. Susan is the Club's advisor and she is also planning to apply for grants to help fund her new position at the high school. Western Youth Services will be applying for San Clemente's Community Grant in mid-January 2014.

d) FAM and Brick's Annual Community Dinner's were both well attended and coordinated. The number of clients that Family Assistance Ministries serves on a monthly basis averages 3,000 per month.

Chair person Kay Childs is spearheading the committee's efforts to update and revise the existing non-profit resource list. She will provide an update at the next regular HAC Meeting.
