## CONSTRUCTION HIGHLIGHTS





**Median Demo Work:** Crews on Monday, May 8, are scheduled to begin nighttime demolition of the I-5 median barrier and adjacent pavement between Camino Capistrano and Camino de Estrella. Demolition work is expected to last up to four weeks.

**Long-term Nightly Lane Reductions:** Crews expect to close the two lanes closest to the median in each direction on the I-5 freeway between Camino Capistrano and Camino de Estrella. The lanes are scheduled to close between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Monday through Friday for the next several months as crews continue median work.

**Avenida Pico:** In the coming weeks, crews will begin working on the expansion of Avenida Pico. Crews will be straightening and widening the road, which will help improve sight distance and mobility. Also, a bike lane will be added in each direction. The work is scheduled through the end of the summer.

**Nighttime Pico Work:** Crews closed Avenida Pico last night to safely pour concrete for the bridge stems and soffit, part of the bridge's infrastructure. Below are photos of the work:

**NB I-5 El Camino Real Ramp Closure:** The northbound I-5 off-ramp to El Camino Real is expected to be closed until mid-May. The closure is part of a safety improvement project to adjust the curve of I-5 at El Camino Real. **PCH Bridge Deck Replacement Project:** Caltrans is replacing the bridge deck on the loop on-ramp from eastbound Camino Las Ramblas to northbound I-5, and the ramp is expected to be closed until mid-June.
