CITY COUNCIL EXTENDS SAN CLEMENTE TROLLEY SERVICE UNTIL SEPTEMBER 30TH WITH DAILY SERVICE BEGINNING AUGUST 13TH, 2018.

7/25/2018...San Clemente, California... Due to the popularity of the San Clemente Trolley and approval of additional grant funding by the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), the San Clemente City Council voted to expand the trolley service to add daily service starting August 13, and also extend the summer operating period to September 30th. The San Clemente Trolley has been operational since Memorial Day Weekend and initially was planned to end on Labor Day. To date, approximately 59,000 people have boarded the trollies. The grants from OCTA require the City to have 6 people board each trolley per hour in the first year and 10 boardings per hour in the following years of service. So far, in its 2nd year, the San Clemente Trolley service has experienced an average ridership of 43 people per hour.

Beginning on Monday, August 13th, 2018, daily service will commence through Sunday, September 30th, 2018, service days and times will be:

- Monday through Friday: 12 noon – 10 pm
- Saturday: 10 am – 10 pm
- Sunday: 10 am – 8 pm
- Labor Day: 10 am – 8 pm

The trolley runs northbound and southbound throughout San Clemente and stops at 16 different locations, which include, but are not limited to:

- The San Clemente Pier
- Avenida Del Mar & Ola Vista
- The Outlets at San Clemente
- The Metrolink train station at North Beach
