### **TENNIS COURT RESURFACING TO INCLUDE PICKLEBALL LINES** ***San Luis Rey Park and San Gorgonio Park will have pickleball lines coming soon***

September 19, 2018...San Clemente, California...On September 4<sup>th</sup> the San Clemente City Council voted to approve a pilot pickleball program that will add pickleball lines to two existing tennis courts in San Clemente – one court at San Luis Rey Park and one court at San Gorgonio Park. Beginning on Monday, September 24 through Friday, October 5, all four courts at San Luis Rey Park will be closed to be resurfaced and get a fresh look with new tennis lines on all courts and four sets of pickleball lines on court #4 (north court). The San Gorgonio Park tennis courts are scheduled to be resurfaced before the end of November 2018. All resurfacing projects are dependent on weather conditions and may be delayed based on inclement weather patterns. Additional information will be made available to the public as the final dates are determined by the Beaches, Parks and Recreation and the Public Works Departments.

Upon completion of the resurfacing projects, San Luis Rey Park court #4 will be designated for priority pickleball use on Sundays and Thursdays; San Gorgonio Park court #2

will be designated for priority pickleball use on Mondays and Wednesdays. All other days will be based on tennis drop-in usage.
