MOBILE HUB FOR LIBRARY SERVICES COMING TO SAN CLEMENTE

January 29, 2015...San Clemente, California...The City of San Clemente in conjunction with the OC Public Libraries, is pleased to announce a Mobile Hub that will launch via a soft opening at the Vista Hermosa Sports Park on Wednesday, February 4th. An official grand opening will be held a week later. The OC Public Libraries' Mobile Hub is a stationary vehicle that will be used as a library and will hold books on shelves that can be accessed by readers. This is the first Mobile Hub of its kind for the OC Public Libraries.

With the San Clemente Public Library closed for construction, the Mobile Hub will help fill the void of not having access to the local library. OC Public Libraries is wrapping the bus to properly identify the Mobile Hub.

The books will be loaded into the Mobile Hub tomorrow, January 30th through Tuesday, February 3rd. The hours of operation will be Noon to 5:00 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday. People will check out a book with their library card using the same process as if they were visiting the San Clemente Public Library. Chrome books will also be available on a limited basis, but must be used on-site and cannot be taken home.
