City of San Clemente to Host Toll Road Town Hall

October 22, 2018...San Clemente, California... The City of San Clemente is hosting a Toll Road Town Hall to provide San Clemente residents and South Orange County neighbors a brief overview of the South County Traffic Relief Effort Project Study Report-Project Development Support (PSR-PDS) conducted by The Foothill/Eastern Transportation Corridor Agency (F/ETCA), part of the Transportation Corridor Agencies (TCA) in cooperation with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 12.

The goal of the Toll Road Town Hall is to take public comments from the community as it relates to the PSR-PDS and forward those comments to the TCA and Caltrans. The PSR-PDS, which serves as the report for TCA-proposed traffic-related projects in South Orange County, including the proposed SR-241 Toll Road Extension and I-5 Managed Toll Lanes Expansion, both of which will result in the taking of public and private land and open space in the City of San Clemente.

Public participation is encouraged following presentations by traffic and mobility experts regarding the proposed Toll Road and other traffic-related plans being proposed by

the TCA. The public may submit written comments/documentation, record a video comment or speak publicly, all of which will be transmitted to the TCA and Caltrans. If anyone would like to send the City comments or documentation in advance of the Toll Road Town Hall, please email the City at:
