City Announces Availability of Draft Sea Level Rise Vulnerability Assessment

July 31, 2019....San Clemente, California... On August 1, 2019, the City's draft Sea Level Rise Vulnerability Assessment (SLRVA) will be available for public review through September 23, 2019. A Staff presentation on the Draft SLRVA is scheduled for the Planning Commission meeting on August 7, 2019. The next day, on August 8, 2019, City Staff will again present the SLRVA to the Coastal Advisory Commission. Following the conclusion of the SLRVA public review period and a public hearing before the City Council tentatively scheduled for Fall 2019, it is anticipated that the SLRVA will be submitted to the California Coastal Commission. The SLRVA is a product of a Local Coastal Program (LCP) Planning Grant awarded to the City in 2016 by the California Coastal Commission. The City is also preparing a companion Coastal Resiliency Plan that will build upon the findings and recommendations contained in the SLRVA.
