### ACTIVE ADVENTURES CAMP POLICY AGREEMENT

The following list states what is expected of all campers each day of camp. Please review these carefully with your child to ensure he or she understands what is considered appropriate behavior while at camp.

- USE OF PERSONAL ITEMS (CELL PHONES, IPODS, ETC):** Campers will refrain from bringing valuable items that could get lost or stolen. Any items brought, will be kept in their personal backpack. As a recreation based program, we strive to release campers from unneeded technology. If you have concerns please contact a staff member. The City is not responsible personal valuables.
- BULLYING/TEASING/LANGUAGE:** Campers will not tease or harass fellow campers, staff, or associated individuals. We maintain a zero tolerance policy in regards to bullying under all circumstances. Should a situation occur, both party's parents will be notified and consequences will follow.

I understand that I am fully responsible for my behavior and actions. I will accept the consequences of my actions and learn from my mistakes. These may include but are not limited to discussion with staff or program supervisor, contact with parent, suspension for a specific period of time, expulsion from the program or any combination therein. All disciplinary actions will be at the direction of the program supervisor depending on the severity of the infraction.
